is a partnership between the Community Health Center and Violet's Cupboard to provide substance abuse treatment and HIV/AIDS prevention and education to the minority "at-risk" population.

Through the combined efforts of Gate House and Violet's Cupboard we are able to guide persons living with HIV and "at-risk" minorities into substance abuse treatment by helping them with their health, family and life issues.

Gate House offers outpatient drug & alcohol treatment, health education and family/individual counseling.

We realize that before we can help you reach your recovery goal you may need assistance in other areas such as housing, food, healthcare and employment assistance. The Case Managers at Gate House will work with you to determine and meet your immediate and long term needs.



Gate House supplies you with the life tools needed to battle the special issues related to HIV/AIDS and substance abuse recovery.



You may qualify for Gate House services if:

- You are living with HIV or are at risk of infection
- You are a minority
- If you use injection drugs
- If you have unprotected sexual activity
- If you take part in any other high-risk behaviors
