Welcome to RAMAR

Since 1983, RAMAR has been a vital part of recovery for chronically addicted individuals in need in Summit County. We serve 14 males and 14 females at our center with quality health care and recovery solutions in a residential and outpatient setting.

Patients may enter RAMAR for



90-120 days, depending on level of care needed. All patients entering RAMAR for treatment must be admitted through the Community Health Center Intake Department. Each RAMAR patient undergoes a clinical assessment and an evaluation from our medical director and staff psychologist prior to entering the facility.

Steps to entering RAMAR

1. Schedule an appointment for an assessment by calling 330-434-4141. Ask for the *Intake Department*.
2. Complete our intake process which includes a clinical and financial assessment.
3. Obtain approval from the ADM Board and CHC's Clinical and Medical Departments.
4. Receive assignment of a counselor at CHC.
5. Enter RAMAR for treatment.

Other Services

Outpatient Program

RAMAR also provides outpatient services to those transitioning out of a residential center, whether it's RAMAR or another local provider.

Transportation

Residential Case Managers provide transportation to appointments, when needed.

Vocational Services

All patients at RAMAR are referred to CommStaff employment agency for vocational services. CommStaff can provide job skills training, job placement and much more.

Parenting Classes

Include group or individual counseling to foster good communication between parent and child. Assist in developing parenting skills. Provides a wide variety of magazines, videos and books on parenting issues.

Medical Services

Monitor and maintain patient's physical well being.

Art Therapy

Learn more about self expression through creative and artistic activities.

Aftercare
