Payment:

Most insurance plans are accepted. Payment of all co-pays and charges not

covered by insurance are due at the time of your appointment.

Co-pays, deductibles and non-covered services are your responsibility to pay.

Prescription Refills:

If you have no refills left on your prescription, you will need to schedule an appointment to see Dr. Bell.

For refills, allow 24-48 hours before calling your pharmacy. Please contact your pharmacy prior to calling us back.

Paperwork:

All paperwork will take between 5-7 business days to process. There is a \$20 fee for all paperwork related to the following:

- Worker's Compensation
- Disability
- Social Security
- Family Medical Leave Act (FMLA)

A fee is charged to transfer records. This includes postage and

\$.10/page. Records cannot be faxed and must be mailed.

Referrals:

Necessary referrals can be made during an appointment with Dr. Bell.

No Shows:

If a patient has 3 no shows within a 6 month period they will be discharged from the Practice. This includes canceled appointments less than 24 hours in advance. New patients that no show cannot reschedule an appointment.
